

ANITA MOSS: The Colorado Springs native and Harrison High superstar won a scholarship and became the University of Arizona's first Volleyball All-American in 1983, leading the Wildcats to the NCAA Tourney in 1982 and 1983. She won four varsity letters at UA for teams that were ranked #11 and #12 in 1982 and 1983. Her Wildcat teams won 81 games in her four seasons. She played in the 1982 USOC National Sports Festival in Indianapolis, and for the USA in the 1983 World University Games. Her career included eight years of international play that included three in Italy on top club teams. She set a number of Arizona volleyball records for individual skills, and was inducted into the University of Arizona Sports Hall of Fame in the Class of 1989. Later, she coached volleyball at Pikes Peak Community College in Colorado Springs.
